Chatham Snowsports Centre has been offering a wide range of activities to members of the public since 1986.

Over the years many thousands of children have learnt to ski and snowboard at our centre.

We also offer a great range of other activities for students of all ages, including Sno-Tubing, Tobogganing & Soft Archery

Our Alpine Lodge Café is the perfect place to grab a bite to eat, a drink, or to just watch people ski and snow/board!



SKIING

Our ski lessons are designed to be both enjoyable and structured, ensuring a fulfilling experience for beginners of all ages. Your students will receive encouragement every step of the way from our experienced instructors. With a maximum pupil to instructor ratio of 1:12, you'll get personalized attention. Our lessons cover basic techniques, safety, and how to ride the lifts. Skis, boots & helmets are included.



SNOWBOARDING

Our snowboarding lessons are designed to be both enjoyable and structured, ensuring a fulfilling experience for beginners of all ages. Your students will receive encouragement every step of the way from our experienced instructors. With a maximum pupil to instructor ratio of 1:10, you'll get personalized attention. Our lessons cover basic techniques, safety, and how to ride the lifts. Snowboards boots & helmets are included.



TOBOGGANING

The UK's longest toboggan at 750 metres, offers an exhilarating and unforgettable ride with fantastic views at the top and thrilling twists and turns down the run.

The lift takes you to the top of the hill and then you are in control throughout run down.

Minimum Age 4 years (4-7 years must ride with an adult).



SNO-TUBING

Sno-tubes are large inflatable rings which can be spun and linked together to slide down the slopes.

They are safe, fun and always popular with all ages. No prior experience needed! Simply get on and enjoy the ride.

GROUP OPTIONS

We have group bookings of all types from schools, to Scouts groups, Guide groups and football teams. We require a minimum of 10 people and a maximum of 12 per instructor for skiing, and a minimum of 8 people and a maximum of 10 per instructor for boarding.

We also offer a multi activity days. Example days start from 10am and finish at 3pm. This consists of a ski and snowboard lesson, Sno-tubing and toboggan sessions, with a lunch break in the middle. Lunch can be included for an additional price. Prices start from £24.00 per student.


To ensure that all those visiting the centre have an enjoyable visit, it is essential that each learning group consists of pupils who are of similar standards.

LEARN BEFORE THEY GO

The Centre specialises in teaching groups of students the skills they need before their winter snowsports trip. Aside from the familiarity of using the equipment it is good to have them turning, stopping and using drag lifts. We can offer this in various options to suit, learn to ski in a day, over the course of 6 weeks, whichever suits.

We do get booked up very quickly at peak times from December to March so please book early with us or come to us in an off peak time!

S.E.N.D. GROUPS

We are happy to accommodate children with additional needs, but we request to be made aware of their requirements prior to your visit.

On many occasions the participant will be able to join in as part of the standard class structure, however there are situations where a one-to-one instructor to pupil ratio is required. Please do contact us if you have any questions, or for us to advise how we can support your individual needs.

DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD

We are happy to support those taking part in their Duke of Edinburgh awards, who may wish to use Skiing or Snowboarding as their physical option. We are aware that the timescale requirements vary depending on your level of badge, so please do ask participants to contact us directly.

SCOUTS SNOWSPORT STAGED ACTIVITY BADGE

Did you know that a 1 hour beginner ski or snowboard lesson completes the criteria to complete the Scouts Snowsport Staged Activity Badge Level 1?



Our group lessons start from 4 years so this is perfect for Squirrels, Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers to try something new and obtain a new badge!

PAYMENT

We are happy to provide an invoice for all group bookings either before or after the booking.

We sometimes require a £50 non-refundable deposit to secure the booking. Please ensure you provide us with final numbers one week prior to the visit.

If for any reason you are unable to make your activity please give us a minimum of one weeks notice.

CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT

All participants for Skiing and Snowboarding lessons are required to wear long trousers, long sleeves and gloves. All equipment is included in the price including helmets for the snowsports activities.

For those taking part in Sno-Tubing and Toboggan they will need to wear fully enclosed, flat shoes.

We are an outdoor facility, and will run in most weather conditions, so please ask the students to dress appropriately to the weather.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Having operated a snowsports centre for many years the Company takes the safety of all visitors as its main priority. The management team at the Centre, are among the most experienced in the country and understand your needs when aiming to bring a group to us.

We have public liability insurance certificates on the pages below and we have complete set of risk assessments that are available on request. Please contact us for more information on these.

There are no licences that are applicable to the operation of outdoor ski slopes. However, our Centres do receive periodical visits from the local council and we utilise independent inspectors to check major equipment throughout the year. John Nike Leisuresport Ltd is the largest outdoor snowsports slope operator in the UK and the market leader with regard to Health and Safety.

All our snowsports instructors are trained and assessed on an annual basis. We train the majority of the instructors more comprehensively than the UK governing bodies.
All staff are DBS checked.
